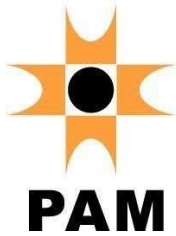

Speaker's Biography (provided by the speaker)

Mr. Felix Quek

Managing Director of MG Ceramics & Homeware Sdn Bhd.

Has more than 30 years of experience in the building industry providing solutions, materials and technical support for installation of ceramic tiles, stones and waterproofing.

Presently Felix runs his own tiling consulting and technical service company offering solutions to a multitude of clients mainly from Japan, Taiwan, Malaysia, Singapore including Australia, New Zealand and China. Felix is also the Technical Consultant Director of an International Joint-Venture manufacturing Cement Based Adhesives (CBAs) in Malaysia with Japanese, Italian, Taiwanese and Singaporean investments. He is also in a venture with an Italian manufacturer for chemical products for the protection, maintenance and restorations for natural stones, agglomerates and ceramic tiles which will set up a production facility in the next 18 months.

Prior to this, he was the Managing Director of a multinational company for 14 years, involving in the manufacturing and supply of a wide range of construction and building materials such as adhesive, repair materials and concrete admixtures. During this tenure, Felix has been instrumental in introducing new and state of the art materials and products to Asia including Japan.

Some of the major projects under Felix were the Singapore Changi Airport Passenger Bldgs Terminal 1,2 and 3 including the current Refurbishing of Terminal 1. Other major projects in Singapore include The Cosmopolitan Condo, ION Mall and Residence, Mapletree Business Centre etc. In Malaysia, KLCC Suria Shopping Centre, Sutera Mall in Jojohe Baru etc. In China, the world biggest hydroelectric dam-The Three Gorges Dam and in Japan, 7 Eleven, Family Mart and Lawson Convenience Stores, Supermarkets, condominiums etc. Since 2006, he is a member in the Technical Committee on Architectural Works, Ceramic Tiles and Wall and Floor tiling under the Singapore Productivity and Innovation Board (SPRING).

Synopsis of Paper

This presentation will cover common tiling failures such as buckling or delamination (debonding) of tiles from the substrate, cracked tiles etc and the possible causes of failure.

It will also briefly mentioned about the different types of ceramic tiles available in the market but will focus mainly on porcelain tiles or commonly known as homogeneous tiles.

The different types and classifications of adhesives will be presented briefly but again only the cement based adhesives will be the topic for the day.

An overview of the system which actually dictates the selection will be highlighted as an after thought.
