Ar Haji Shahriman Abdullah

Being in love with the arts in his schooling time, Ar. Haji Shahriman pursued Architectural studies in the University of Technology Malaysia, Kuala Lumpur and graduated in 1980 with a Bachelor of Architecture Degree. He worked in Kuala Lumpur with Perunding Alam Bina and during his stint in the well-known firm, he was sent by the Federal Government to Chicago Illinois, USA under transfer of technology to Perkins & Wills, specialising in planning and design of hospitals in Chicago, USA and internationally. Upon returning to Malaysia, Ar. Haji Shahriman was involved with two hospitals and a teaching hospital in the peninsular.

He returned to Sabah in 1984 to join the Development of Housing and Town Board (LPPB) as the Chief Architect.
