

PAM crowned darts champs for third consecutive time

KOTA KINABALU: PAM Sabah Chapter won the Darts championship title for the third time consecutively after battling for 12 hours during the Inter Professional Bodies Games (IPB Games) 2022 - Darts, which was held on November 26-27 at the OMG Darts Cafe, Taman Suria Penampang.

The event is held once every two years among the seven professional bodies in Sabah, comprising PAM Sabah Chapter (PAM), The Institution of Engineers Malaysia (IEM), Malaysian Medical Association (MMA), Malaysian Institute of Accountants (MIA), Sabah Pharmaceutical Society (SPS), Royal Institution of Surveyors Malaysia (RISM) and Sabah Laws Society (SLS), to promote the fellowship among the professions

and the games of sports.

However, the IPB Games 2020 had to be cancelled because of the Covid-19 pandemic.

There are ten games to be played, namely, table tennis, badminton, volleyball, basketball, golf, darts, 9-ball pool, futsal, football and esports.

The IPB Games 2022 kicked off with futsal on August 6 and is scheduled to finish by January 14, 2023. Most of the other games are still in progress.

"It was very encouraging to see the positive response with so many young darters from the various professions this year and the improvement in the standard of the game," said Ar. Victor Wong, the Organising Captain from PAM. "There were two bull's

eye checkouts, one from SPS and the other from PAM. The highest checkout was 120 when PAM's Ar. Victor Wong set up the 120 for his teammate Enzo Mathew to checkout in triple 20, 20 and then double 20 during the Team Event against SPS for an exciting finish."

PAM won the Gold Championship Trophy with six wins, IEM the Silver Trophy with 4 wins, while the Bronze Trophy was won by MMA with three wins, winning on count back over SLS by one frame. The 4th position was won by SLS followed by SPS (5th), RISM (6th) and MIA (7th).

The trophies were presented by Datuk Ar Shahrizan Abdullah, the Chairman of PAM Sabah Chapter.
