MIA emerge 9-ball pool champs

KOTA KINABALU: Malaysian Institute of Accountants (MIA) Sabah Branch emerged as the 9-ball pool champions in a tightly fought match, after defeating the defending champions PAM for gold, while IEM (bronze) came third after defeating SPS in the 14th Inter Professional Bodies Games 2022.

The competition was organised by PAM Sabah Chapter and was held over two days at the Champion Cupid Sdn Bhd, 1st Floor, Kedai Plaza Utama, Penampang on December 3-4, under the league system where all the competing teams played against each other, under the categories of Man Single (MS), Women Single (WS), Men Double1 (MD1), Men Double2 (MD2) and Mixed Double (XD).

The event is held once every two years among the seven professional bodies in Sabah, comprising Malaysian Institute of Architects, Sabah Chapter (PAM), The Institution of Engineers Malaysia, Sabah Branch (IEM), Malaysian Medical Association, Sabah Branch (MMA), Malaysian Institute of Accountants, Sabah Branch (MIA), Sabah Pharmaceutical Society (SPS), Royal Institution of Surveyors Malaysia, Sabah Branch (RISM) and Sabah Laws Society (SLS), to promote the fellowship among the professions and the games of sports.

However, the IPB Games 2020 had to be cancelled because of the Covid-19 pandemic.
